

Invitation to Bid: RB-2018-001

Second Touch Programming of Mobile and Portable Radios

Questions & Answers

1. Are any of the 3 bonds required for this bid?

Section 3, Paragraph 11 – “Required Bonds” of General Terms and Conditions (Appendix 1) does not apply to this procurement.

2. Will personalities be provided by the customer?

Yes. Each jurisdiction will provide radio personalities to the selected vendor.

3. Does customer have software for Harris and Motorola units?

Yes. Radio Board will provide software for Harris units for this effort. The Radio Board has no Motorola units or software.

4. How many locations will be available per jurisdiction?

The Radio Board encourages bidders to provide any additional/supplemental information that may be helpful as they review bids. This may include suggestions from bidders on minimum number of locations per jurisdiction that the bidder feels would optimize time and performance for this effort. Once the vendor has been selected, logistical details will be negotiated to a level that is mutually agreeable to all parties.

5. Has there been any logistics that have been discussed for each jurisdiction on how many radios will be available at one time and locations?

Yes, the Radio Board has discussed how many radios would be available to any one time at any one location. The Radio Board has structured the Bid Form in such a manner to solicit information that will aid in determining how they will direct departments in the jurisdictions to respond to the 2nd touch programming effort. The Radio Board encourages bidders to provide any additional/supplemental information that may be helpful as they review bids. This may include suggestions from bidders on minimum number radios per location per trip that the bidder feels would optimize time and performance for this effort. Once the vendor has been selected, logistical details will be negotiated to a level that is mutually agreeable to all parties.
